Facilities and Technology Committee Resolution No. 1  
Protective Measures against Active Shooters

---

**PURPOSE:** To call for The George Washington University Law School to install ADA-compliant locks or latches, capable of locking doors from the inside in all classrooms; as a preventive measure in the instance of an active shooter.

**WHEREAS:** In the name of students' utmost safety the threat of an active shooter on campus must be protected against;

**WHEREAS:** Bylaw 404 allows the Senate Facilities and Technology Committee to monitor and respond in a timely fashion to facilities complaints received from the student body;

**WHEREAS:** The Facilities and Technology Committee, by majority vote on August 24, 2019 approved the installation of interior (bolt or similar) locks in all classrooms;

**BE IT RESOLVED:** The GW Law SBA Senate requests that ADA-compliant locks or latches, capable of locking doors from the inside, be installed on all classrooms in the Law School complex.
